Competition Details

- Super 16 is played over 8 rounds over four Saturdays between March and August.
- There will be two rounds each day. Round 1 will start at 10.30am and Round 2 will start at 2.30pm. * Rounds 3 & 4 on the 6th May will be held in Arena 3 and the start times will be an hour earlier than normal.
- Entry is Open
- It will be played using the last 16 draw. All matches will be best of 5 games
- Based on a cup, plate, bowl, shield competition format, all players will end up with a final placing 1st-16th each round and accumulate points as follows 1st gains 16 points, 2nd gains 15 points ...to 16th gains 1 point.
- The overall winner of Super 16 will be determined from a player's best 6 scores total over 8 rounds of the competition.

How to Play

- Players must register for each individual round they want to play.
- Registration for each round will close **8 days** before the round takes place.

- The top 16 registered players for each round will be selected to compete.
- To determine the selected 16 players for each round, the latest Manawatu Rating List will be used first. If a registered player does not have a current Manawatu Rating, then that player's current New Zealand Rating will be taken into account. Players who don't have a Manawatu or NZ Rating may need an assessment to see where they fit in.
- All players who have registered will be notified the weekend prior whether or not they have made the top 16. The next highest 2 or 3 players will be put on a waiting list and may be called up to play closer to the time if someone selected becomes unable to compete.

The Draw

- All players will be placed into a last 16 draw.
 - There will be 4 seeds.
 - The seeds for each round will be determined from the Manawatu Rating List and NZ rating list if a player doesn't have a current Manawatu Rating at the close of entries.
- All remaining players will be randomly placed into the last 16 draw.
- A live draw will be completed for each round 15 minutes before play begins.

More Details

- To play, you don't have to sign up to play every round. Players can choose to register just for the rounds they are available and want to play.
 - Reminder emails and texts will be sent out to all players who would like reminders sent when the next rounds are coming up. Players must contact Matthew with their details for this.
 - Initial registrations will only be taken for Rounds 1 and 2. After the completion of those rounds, registration will open for the next two rounds and so on.
 - If less than 16 players contest a round, the format of the competition may differ than what is stated under competition details. This is to ensure all players play a minimum of 4 matches a round and still end up with a final position.
- There will be no prize money for the overall winner. Prize money will only be paid to the top 3 finishes in each round. Prize money amounts will differ from what is stated if there are less than 16 players in a round.
- Prize Money will be distributed in the following amounts where there are less than 16 players.

15 players – 1st \$40, 2nd \$20, 3rd \$10

14 players – 1st \$35, 2nd \$20, 3rd \$5

13 players – 1st \$35, 2nd \$15

12 players – 1st \$25, 2nd \$15

11 players – 1st \$20 2nd \$10

10 players – 1st \$20

9 players – 1st \$10
